2. **NAME & COMPETITION DATES :**

- Rajasthan Senior State Judo Championships – 2025 - 26 (Senior Men & Women)
- 30th to 31st March 2026

3. **VENUE :** S M S Stadium JUDO Hall, Jaipur

4. **DEADLINES:** Final Entry to RSJA: No later than 28th March 2026

5. **WEIGHT CATEGORIES (INDIVIDUAL) :**

7. **ELIGIBILITY :**

- a. Players must be born in 2011 or before (Above 15 YEARS IN CALENDAR YEAR).
- b. All competitors must participate from their District from where they have obtained their Registration to RSJA. Only Registered player and officials will be eligible to participate.
- c. A player who is under 18 years will participate at his/her own risk and responsibility and a NO OBJECTION Certificate (NOC) from parents/guardian will be required to submit before he/she is accredited for Championships.

8. **CONTROL OF ENTRIES OF THE ATHLETES:**

The control of entry of the athletes will take place at venue on 30th March 2026 for Men & 31st March 2026 for Women **till 10.am**. Each head of District must be present, during the control of participants, with proof of their Date of Birth like Passport and Aadhar Card/Driving License/Voter ID any other documents approved by the Government of India, or valid JFI Registration Card.

9. ENTRIES:

- a. Each District Units can enter only a player in each of the above weight categories.
 - b. Entries MUST BE signed by the respective District President/Secretary and submit to RSJA Email : rsjajudo@gmail.com on or before 28th March 2026 by 5.p.m.
 - c. Original Entry Forms duly signed by the respective District President/Secretary must be submitted during the Accreditation. It is mandatory of the signature and stamp of the respective District President/Secretary on the Final Entry Forms.
 - d. Any athlete/officials is eligible to entry in the competition provided he/she is:
 - Not under a disciplinary suspension.
 - Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation..
- **Not under medical suspension.**
- Healthy and fit for competition.
 - Do not carry any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.
 - Participating athletes must be born in 2011 or before.
 - Sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix and understand fully the IJF/JFI sport and refereeing rules.

10. METHODS OF COMPETITION:

Competition system: Competition will be conducted in accordance with the IJF and JFI Sports and Organization Rules, and IJF Refereeing Rules.

11. DURATION:

MEN : 4 (Four) minutes

WOMEN : 4 (Four) minutes

12. WEIGH-IN:

- (a) Contestant in categories must fall strictly with in the lower & upper limits of that weight category.
- (b) Contestants are advised to come adequately prepared with proper gymnastic under clothing for the weigh-in
- (c) Each competitor will be allowed on the weigh-in scale only once during official weigh-in.

13. FEMINITY CONTROL:

A medical certificate of Players in English/Hindi issued by a qualified Gynaecologist of the players State/Department, attesting the Sex & No pregnancy of the women players, must be submitted on demand of the Technical Official – RSJA. Female players have to carry the same during the event.

14. DRAWS :

The draws will be held on the 30th March 2026 at 12.p.m. For WOMEN & 31st March 2026 at 12.p.m. For MEN at Venue. Representative of each participating District , may attend the draws ceremony/meeting. Maximum two members from each District. Will be allowed for the Draws.

15. TECHNICAL OFFICIAL :

- a. RSJA will appoint Technical Officials to perform functions of sporting & refereeing and other technical functions.
- b. All Technical Officials are required to report on the morning of 30th March 2026 by 7 AM and to attend Refereeing/Sporting Meetings and as per the communication from the Tournament Director.

16. AWARDS - CERTIFICATES:

- a. Winner in each category will awarded a Gold plated Medal and Merit Certificate.
- b. Runner-up in each weight category will be awarded a Silver plated Medal and Merit Certificate.
- c. The Third place winner (2 third places) will be awarded a Bronze plated Medal and Merit Certificates.

17. BOARDING , LODGING :

NOTE : No lodging will be provided to players only boarding will be provide.

18. DISQUALIFICATION :

A.In case of any player is disqualified by any reason, eligibility, his/her expenses will not be borne by the Organisers, and Certificate of Participation will NOT be issued to any disqualified player.

B.In case of any damage caused by any team member, the cost will have to be paid by the Manager, before team departure.

C.Any player and/or official who by word, action or deed disrupts and or/interrupts the smooth and normal conduct of the Championships on or off the mat, he/she will be liable for immediate disqualification, and the RSJA Disciplinary Committee will take appropriate action.

D.The Sport commission of RSJA will finally check the eligibility (technical) of judokas for issuing the participation certificate to athletes (as mandated in IJF SOR).

19. INSURANCE:

Each District Unit must assure all responsibility of accident/illness/miss-happening etc. and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials for participating in the Rajasthan Senior State Judo Championships 2025-26. The RSJA do not accept any responsibility in this regard. It is requested to make necessary insurance coverage for all team

members.

20. JUDO GI & Control :

Judo Dress:

- All players must have both WHITE & BLUE Judogi. In case of blue corner the player must wear the BLUE Judogi, which is COMPULSARY.
- All players must compete wearing an IJF/JFI approved Judogi or Indian Brands:. Judogi must be as per the specifications of IJF/JFI Rules.
- Judogi Control will be operated with a Judogi measurement scale prior to the fight. If any athlete/player disqualify his Judogi, he/she will be disqualified from the bout.
- If any athlete wears the BLACK BELT without a gradation will be disqualified from the bout.

21. ANTI -DOPING :

Doping test will be carried out in accordance with the rules by WADA/NADA. All the Judo Players must cooperate with the NADA Officials for the Ant-Doping process on demand.

22. RSJA REGISTRATION, INSCRIPTION & ENTRY FEE:

a. RSJA Registration:

No registration, inscription, or team entry fees will be charged by the Rajasthan State Judo Association from the participating district units or athletes.

23. MEDAL CEREMONY :

All the medal winners (1st, 2nd and both 3rd place) must be present for the Medal Ceremony with White Judogi on the announcement.
